Notice to Exhibitors

These shows will be judged and run by the Show Rules of the Australian Shepherd Club of America. All dogs, six months or older must have an **ASCA Registration Number or ASCA QTracker Number** (for Agility, Obedience or Rally) in order to compete and earn titles in ANY venue (please have a copy of this number available at the show.) This includes purebred and non -purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's mental or physical performance or dogs exhibiting any signs of aggression toward people or other dogs. As of January 1, 2003, ASCA requires registration of all non-ASCA registered dogs in order to track and record these dogs for ASCA titles. To have your qualifying scores recorded and receive ASCA titling certificates, you must register your dog and become a service member of ASCA at the time of registration. Forms will be available at the registration table and at www.asca.org the ASCA website.

Dogs of any registry may enter Obedience/Rally classes in ASCA Sanctioned Shows. It is a requirement in Obedience/Rally that all competing dogs have either **ASCA registration or a QTracker number** to enter. Titles will be issued upon completion of requirements. No Exhibition Only. For complete rules & regulations, call ASCA at (979) 778-1082 or go to www.asca.org All Rally exhibitors must start in Novice.

—QTRACKER NUMBER APPLICATION FORMS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE REGISTRATION TABLE—

*** In order to have ASCA qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA QTracker Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type of Service is required). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify to ASCA the shows and legs earned when applying for a QTracker Number for those ASCA qualifying legs earned from 1/1/2003 until submission of application. See obedience rules at www.asca.org

The management will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee be asked to leave the site. In such case, no entry fees will be refunded. No entry shall be accepted for a dog or handler disqualified from ASCA Rally programs; a dog or handler disqualified from all other ASCA programs or a member not in good standing with ASCA. A list of such dogs will be supplied by the business office along with the sanctioning paperwork. Dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring. Please clean up after yourself and your dog. No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disobedience, fire, public emergency, act of God or act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee, except as noted above. There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless for the reason for the dismissal. Refunds will be issued for bitches that come in season, if notification in writing or by email is received before the trial begins. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$30.00 service charge for returned checks. Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside or outside the ring, must be excused from the trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform the course in a safe manner will be excused from the trial.

COVID RELATED INFORMATION

CASC will follow suggested state and local rules regarding to running of these shows. Safety is our first concern, for all... judges, workers, and exhibitors. At the present, we are planning to run under these guidelines; if conditions warrant, the show may be cancelled or postponed, if the COVID-19 situation changes or conditions are enforced, not allowing us to continue. If the show is cancelled, entry checks will be destroyed.

Masks and social distance will be required. COVID-19 waivers will be signed before entry into building. There will be no crating in the building. Exhibitors will be called to enter the building when their turn approaches. Three exhibitors will be allowed in the building at one time – one showing, in the ring, one warming up in the specified area, and one waiting to warm-up. When the showing exhibitor leaves the building, the next exhibitor will enter. Other people in the building will be the judge and CASC members running the show. There should be no more the 10 people in the facility at any time.

Competitors showing symptoms or with relatives showing symptoms must stay home and not participate in events. People who test positive or have relatives that test positive for coronavirus should follow their state and local quarantine rules.

Social distancing should be observed indoors and outdoors. Masks will be required; Handlers should bring their own masks. Sanitizing will be carried out throughout the day, to minimize possible contamination. Hand sanitizer will be available for judges, entry clerks, ring stewards, and exhibitors. Wash hands often and keep hands away from face.

Rally: Judges, stewards, and competitors will wear masks. Extra time is allowed for multiple walk-thrus, depending on the number of entries received. Judges will maintain a distance of 6' between themselves and the handler, and between all handlers in the ring at the same time. Awards will be self-serve, after scores are announced.

Obedience: ASCA recommends training dogs to accept people and judges in masks. Obedience handlers should wash and sanitize equipment such as gloves, dumbbells, articles, etc. as often as possible. Judges will maintain a distance of 6' between themselves and the handler, and between all handlers in the ring at the same time. A chair will be placed inside the ring, for handlers to place their dumbbells, gloves, article bags, leashes, etc. After leashing their dog, after the last exercise, the handler will gather their personal belongings from the chair, before exiting the ring. Awards will be self-serve, after scores are announced.

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IMPORTANT LEGAL AGREEMENT—Please read the following carefully as it, among other things, may prevent you from suing ASCA® and persons/entities affiliated with it. This agreement could even require you to defend them from demands and suits by third parties that include an assertion of wrongdoing by you. (1) The person signing this Agreement represents being authorized to enter into it on behalf of him/herself, as well as (if different) the owner(s)/exhibitor(s)/handler(s) of the dog(s) for which an entry form is being submitted (all these parties collectively referred to herein as "Applicant"). (2) "Releasees" here collectively refers to the Australian Shepherd Club of America® (ASCA®); its affiliate clubs; and the officers and board of directors, staff, contractors, insurers, attorneys, and agents of ASCA® and of those clubs. (3) This Agreement voluntarily is entered into by Applicant in exchange for the acceptance of the associated entry form and permission to participate in related activities. (4) Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations applicable to this event. (5) Applicant certifies that the entered dog will not pose a hazard to people, property, stock animals, or other dogs, and further that the dog is current with rabies shots along with any other vaccinations required by its state of residence. (6) Applicant acknowledges and assumes the risks to Applicant and Applicant's dog associated with participation in the event, among which could be ones associated with poor condition of the facilities and surrounding areas; security measures or lack of them; electrical appliances; fittings; show rings; the presence of unfamiliar persons; and the presence/involvement of other animals—whether stock, dogs, or otherwise. (7) Applicant further agrees to comply with all recommended and required health and safety precautions, among which may be those related to social distancing; quarantining; wearing of face coverings; and non-participation of persons exhibiting symptoms or for whom there otherwise has been a likelihood of recent exposure to COVID-19 or other contagious diseases. (8) Applicant additionally acknowledges and agrees to assume the risks associated with taking part in the event though others might neglect compliance with health and safety precautions/requirements or pose an undue risk of spreading disease. For example, as is true as to any public event, there is some risk that Applicant and/or those affiliated with Applicant may catch COVID-19 or another contagious disease at the event. (9) To the maximum extent permissible, this release is to be interpreted under Texas law, without application of its choice of law rules. (10) To the extent that Applicant—or another party suing on behalf of Applicant, or suing to recover based on injuries/death/damage to Applicant/Applicant's dog/Applicant's property—sues ASCA® (or a board member or staff member or agent of ASCA®) as a defendant, the sole appropriate forum (to the maximum extent permitted by law) for the suit shall be the state or federal courts serving Brazos County, Texas (where ASCA® has its headquarters). (11) Applicant hereby releases and waives any claims Applicant otherwise might assert against the Releasees as to any injury or damage claim connected in any way to any alleged act or omission arising out of, or occurring concurrent with, the event and related activities, interactions, communications, and even adjacent premises. (12) This release is made not only as to Applicant but also for anyone who might assert a claim on behalf of Applicant or based on purported injury or damage to Applicant/Applicant's dog/Applicant's property, as well as any heir, beneficiary, assignee, executor, trustee, agent, or survivor of Applicant. (13) Applicant further agrees to assume sole responsibility for and indemnify and hold Releasees harmless from related claims, demands, judgments, and settlement payments. (14) These waiver, release, and indemnification provisions extend even to claims or demands asserting that the acts or omissions resulted in bodily injury or death or from intentional wrongdoing, as well as to attorney fees and other costs of defense. (15) The duties of indemnification further extend to any claims or demands asserted against Releasees that are alleged to have arisen out of the acts or omissions of Applicant, Applicant's dog, or others affiliated with Applicant. Among other things, this means that Applicant would pay the legal defense of Releasees if someone sued them based on a claim Applicant carelessly exposed the claimant to COVID-19. (16) Applicant's promises in this agreement apply without regard to the type of claim or cause of action asserted against Releasees. (17) To the extent any provision of this agreement is unenforceable, the remainder of it nonetheless is to be enforced. (18) This agreement is to be interpreted to provide Releasees with the maximum permissible legal protection from—among other things—claims and suits pursued by Applicant (and/or those acting on behalf of Applicant or over injury/damage to Applicant), as well as from ones based on the purported wrongful acts or omissions of Applicant. (19) Nothing in this Agreement requires you to indemnify Releasees from claims by third parties that involve no allegations of improper acts or omissions by you, those affiliated with you, nor your dog(s). (20) Applicant acknowledges having read, understood, and had the opportunity for independent legal review of this document prior to signing it.
